"My son was very shy and introverted and through the groups he has been attending over the past few years at Chapel FM he has become a confident and outgoing young man. He has special needs and has told me that at chapel fm he feels 'normal' that is a fantastic thing for a mum to hear."

"Chapel FM provides affordable courses for both young people and adults in the old chapel building in Seacroft. This allows young people to take part in music, broadcasting and arts events that they would probably not have had access to before. My own daughter gained a place on a 'next gen' music course 6 years ago and has kept on going. Chapel FM has given her confidence to take part in events and performances and she has gained her bronze and silver arts awards here. She is currently part of the Grads group, a group of her peers who help organise courses and events for other young people. Chapel FM has inspired her and other youngsters like her through the arts to achieve and also give back to the community. This is an all-inclusive environment that inspires all who attend."
